	Items to Bring on the Day of Your Arthroplasty Surgery	
	Identification: Ensure you bring your passport, as it is required for identification purposes.	
	Clothing: Pack loose, comfortable clothing to wear during your recovery, such as: Tracksuits or pajamas, T-shirts or button-up shirts, a bathrobe (optional). Please include underwear and extra clothing for your stay.	
	Footwear: Indoor: Non-slip, comfortable slippers for use in the hospital. Outdoor: Flat, rubber-soled sneakers for safe and comfortable mobility after discharge.	
	Medical Devices: Bring any essential medical devices (e.g., glasses, contact lenses, hearing aids, or dentures) along with their designated storage cases.	
	Medications: Bring all your prescribed medications in their original packaging.	
	Personal Care Products: While most personal care items are provided by the hospital, you may bring your own preferred items, such as a nail clipper, razor, adult diapers, sanitary pads, or wet wipes.	
	Assistive Walking Devices: After surgery, you may require a walker or crutches for mobility. While a walker will be provided during your hospital stay, it is recommended to arrange for a suitable assistive walking device for use after discharge.	
	inportant Notes	
0	Do not consume any food or drink for at least 8 hours before your surgery.	
0	Medications: If you take blood pressure medication, take it at the usual time with a small sip of water. Do not take any other medications for chronic conditions unless instructed otherwise by your doctor.	
0	Pacemaker Identification: Patients with a pacemaker must present their pacemaker identification card to the medical staff once the surgery decision is confirmed.	
0	Nail Care: Remove all nail polish and artificial nails before arriving for surgery.	
0	Jewelry and Accessories: Do not wear any jewelry, including necklaces, rings, bracelets, or watches, on the day of surgery.	
0	Dentures: If you wear dentures, they must be removed before surgery. Please remember to	



bring a case for your dentures and take them with you after the procedure.
